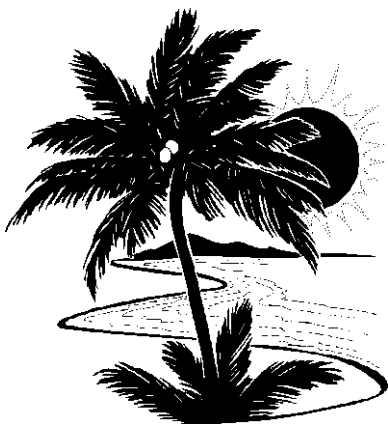
January Meeting
